

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3. The RREC is tasked to:
- examine and verify all research proposals involving human participants (especially learners) to ensure compliance with ethical standards;
  - grant ethics clearance or exemption certificates for research proposals;
  - monitor ongoing research for adherence, require modifications or disapprove proposals that pose ethical concerns;
  - provide guidance on research activities align with DepEd policies;
  - promote awareness and training on research ethics among DepEd personnel and researchers on ethical considerations in research design and implementation;
  - maintain records of ethics reviews, decisions, minutes of meetings, and issued clearances required by law; and
  - facilitate virtual or remote ethics review processes, including secure handling of digital submissions and use of digital signatures.
4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
