This event aims to recognize the journalistic excellence of the secondary and tertiary campus journalists, and to highlight the importance of journalistic narratives beyond the campus.





## V. GUIDELINES (MAJOR CATEGORIES)

### **A. MOST OUTSTANDING CAMPUS JOURNALIST (USA PUBLICATIONS' JOSE MIJARES AND JOSE SANCHEZ AWARD)**

1. This award is named in honor of Jose Mijares and Jose Sanchez, high school students who founded campus journalism in 1927 at the Colegio de San Agustin de Iloilo (now University of San Agustin) and initiated what later became the USA Publications, the school's official student press corps.
2. This award is open to graduating secondary (Grade 12) and tertiary (4th or 5th year) campus journalists nationwide.
3. Each school/publication may nominate **one candidate only**; more than one submission results in disqualification.
4. The nominee must be approved by the school's selection committee.
5. The nominee must be an active member of a recognized campus publication during the current academic year.
6. The nominee must have produced original journalistic works, officially published, aired, or released through a campus or institutional platform.
7. The nominee must demonstrate adherence to journalistic ethics, accuracy, objectivity, and fairness.
8. Shows consistent contributions to campus journalism and exhibits leadership, initiative, and responsibility.
9. For the list of supporting documents:
  - a. Nominee form (see next page for template)
  - b. Endorsement letter from the school
  - c. List and supporting documents of Academic Achievements, Leadership Roles, Community Service, Journalism-Related Awards (from 2022 to 2026 only)
  - d. Sample of works published (maximum of 10)
10. All documents must be compiled into **one PDF file** and submitted via the **Google Drive link** attached to the Google Form Registration.

11. The nominee that accumulates the highest total score shall receive a trophy and certificate as **Most Outstanding Campus Journalist (USA Publications' Jose Mijares and Jose Sanchez Awardee)**.

### **B. MOST OUTSTANDING MODERATOR (USA PUBLICATIONS' ANITA BELLOSILLO AWARD)**

1. This award is open to school paper advisers or moderators of secondary or tertiary campus publications nationwide.
2. Each school/publication may nominate **one candidate only**; more than one submission results in disqualification.
3. The nominee must be endorsed and approved by the school's selection committee.
4. The nominee must have actively served as a school paper adviser or moderator for the school's official publication during the current academic year.
5. For the list of supporting documents:
  - a. Nominee form (see next page for template)
  - b. Endorsement letter from the school
  - c. List and supporting documents of trainings or seminars attended related to campus journalism, leadership roles, community service, journalism related-awards of the nominee or certificates as official coach of staff members who have won journalism awards (from 2022 to 2026 only)
6. All documents must be compiled into **one PDF file** and submitted via the **Google Drive link** attached to the Google Form Registration.
7. The nominee that accumulates the highest total score shall receive a trophy and certificate as **Most Outstanding Moderator (USA Publications' Anita Bellosillo Awardee)**.

## VI. GUIDELINES (MINOR CATEGORIES)

### A. BEST TABLOID/NEWSPAPER

1. This category is open to **secondary and tertiary publications nationwide**.
2. The participating publications that wish to join the school paper contest must submit a **PDF copy** of their school newspaper via a Google Drive link to be attached to the Google Form Registration.
3. Publication entries to be submitted should be the latest available published newspaper within the academic years 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 only.
4. The participating publications cannot submit any entry that has already been submitted in the previous SanAg Campus Press Awards.
5. Participating publications can only submit a maximum of one (1) tabloid/newspaper.
6. The number of pages for the school paper should be a minimum of 12 pages. All pages are in full color with a size of 12" x 18".
7. The school publication that accumulates the highest total score in the tabloid/newspaper category shall receive a trophy and certificate as **National Winner - Best Tabloid/Newspaper**. One (1) additional publication shall receive an **Honorary Citation**, along with a trophy and certificate.
8. External judges will determine the winners for this category. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable.

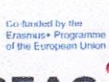
### B. BEST LITERARY FOLIO

1. This category is open to **secondary and tertiary publications nationwide**.
2. The participating publications that wish to join the Best Literary Folio contest must submit a **PDF copy** of their output via a Google Drive link to be attached to the Google Form Registration.
3. Entries may consist of one or multiple literary genres, including poetry, fiction, creative non-fiction, and drama.

4. All works must be properly titled and dated and must strictly adhere to ethical and academic integrity standards; plagiarism in any form is prohibited.
5. There is no minimum or maximum number of pages for the literary folio submission.
6. The school publication that accumulates the highest total score in the literary folio category shall receive a trophy and certificate as **National Winner - Best Literary Folio**. One (1) additional publication shall receive an **Honorary Citation**, along with a trophy and certificate.
7. External judges will determine the winners for this category. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable.

### C. BEST CAMPUS PUBLICATION FACEBOOK PAGE

1. The Facebook page must have at least **3,000 followers**.
2. The page must be fully set up with complete profile information, feature original content, promote verified development communication, and actively engage with followers.
3. The publication must **provide a list of content types published**, with a brief explanation for each, supporting documentation, and the link to the official Facebook page.
4. All documents must be compiled into one PDF file and submitted via the Google Drive link attached to the Google Form Registration.
5. The school publication that accumulates the highest total score shall receive a trophy and certificate as **National Winner - Best Campus Publication Facebook Page**. One (1) additional publication shall receive an **Honorary Citation**, along with a trophy and certificate.
6. External judges will determine the winners for this category. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable.

## VII. GUIDELINES (SPECIAL CATEGORIES)

### A. 7TH SANAG JOURNALISM QUIZ BEE

1. The 7th SanAg Journalism Quiz Bee is open to all junior and senior high school students who are members of their **high school publications**.
2. **Each team must consist of three (3) members.**
3. The registration fee is ₱350 per publication, which covers the participation of all three team members and 1 coach, inclusive of snacks and kits.
4. In the quiz bee, the contestants will be provided with cardboard and chalk for them to use.
5. No published dictionaries or thesauruses will be allowed. Mobile devices, including cell phones, tablets, or any of their digital media, are prohibited.
6. Moderators/Advisors are prohibited from coaching and they are prohibited from roaming outside their designated area during the competition proper.
7. The Quiz Bee is divided into three categories: **easy, average, and difficult**. Each category will have a corresponding score that the contestant will receive. Two (2) points will be given to each correct answer in the easy category, four (4) points for the average, and seven (7) points for the difficult category.
8. All categories will have a total of ten (10) questions. Each question for the easy and average rounds will have a 10-second allotted time to be answered, while for the difficult round, 20 seconds will be given. A sound will be heard when the time is up.
9. The three (3) teams with the highest number of points will be proclaimed the winners.
10. In cases of ties, there will be a clincher round. In the Clincher Round, the scores will go back to zero. Every question asked is equivalent to five (5) points. Whoever gets the first 25 points will be deemed the winner.
11. Questions will be made by the organizers and checked by the quiz master. **Journalism, current events, trivia, and Filipino and English grammar questions will be the scope of the quiz bee.**

13. The participants shall wear their school uniform and their official school ID on the day of the competition.

### Prizes:

- 1st Place – Medal, Certificate of Recognition, and Php 3,000 cash prize
- 2nd Place – Medal, Certificate of Recognition and Php 2,000 cash prize
- 3rd Place – Medal, Certificate of Recognition and Php 1,500 cash prize

## B. 3RD #KUWENTONIGUSTING: STUDENT DOCUMENTARY COMPETITION

With its third edition, #KuwentoNiGusting reaffirms USA Publications' dedication to amplifying student narratives through documentary storytelling among young journalists. The contest is open to all **secondary and tertiary publications**.

1. A team composed of five (5) members from the official publication's editorial staff, including a director, narrator, scriptwriter, videographer, and video editor, shall be allowed.
2. Student journalists are invited to create documentaries featuring themselves, sharing what they believe is the most pressing issue in their community or in the country. They may focus on a significant topic and discuss the role and power of the campus press in promoting **public accountability**. Participants are encouraged to reflect on why this issue is important now, why it needs to be addressed, and what concrete steps can be taken to create positive change, highlighting the unique perspective and agency of youth in shaping their communities.
3. The minimum duration of the video should be five (5) minutes, and must not exceed ten (10) minutes.
4. The participants have the freedom to narrate the documentary either in English or Filipino.
5. The use of mobile phones, DSLR or digital cameras, and microphones during the video shooting is allowed.

6. The sound to be used must be original. Non-copyrighted background music may also be utilized.
7. All video footage must be original. If the participants want to use stock footage, proper credit must be made for the duration of the video.
8. Participants cannot submit any entry that has already been submitted in the last #KwentoNiGusting.
9. Any video editing software or application (such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Wondershare Filmora Go, or Capcut) is allowed.
10. The use of vulgar language, illegal drugs, and potentially dangerous materials (such as weapons and firearms) is strictly prohibited.
11. The entry shall represent the non-partisan nature of the press and shall, therefore, not in any way promote any political candidate.
12. The entry should include source credits at the end of the video.
13. Those who are found to have plagiarized will automatically be disqualified.
14. The use of artificial intelligence-generated photos, videos, music, and other documentary materials will automatically result in disqualification.
15. Failure to follow the above instructions will deduct points and may result in disqualification.

- 1st Place – Trophy, Certificate of Recognition, and Php 5,000 cash prize
- 2nd Place – Certificate of Recognition and Php 3,000 cash prize
- 3rd Place – Certificate of Recognition and Php 1,500 cash prize
