

### 2026 Negros Island Teachers' Summit Concept Note

Hosted by **Silliman University Faculty Association (SUFA)** and co-organized by the **Alliance of Concerned Teachers – Negros Island Region Union (ACT-NIR Union)**, the “Teacher’s Summit” is a gathering of public and private school teachers in the Negros Island Region (NIR). First ever of its kind, this is scheduled on February 28, 2025 and to be held at the Audio-Visual Theater (AVT) of Silliman University, Dumaguete City.

As an independent union of academic personnel of Silliman University, SUFA believes that labor unions in the education sector must not only advocate and advance the interest and welfare of teachers and students. We must also engage and actively participate in policy making and collectively lobby for educational policies that “promote total human liberation” and “national development” (1987 Philippine Constitution).

ACT-NIR Union, as the newly established regional teachers’ union in Negros Island, wishes to build the solidarity of our teachers in our region in advancing a truly empowering education, along with all the campaigns for teachers’ rights and welfare. Through collaboration and collective action, the Union envisions to gather together our teachers in Negros Oriental to formulate solutions on the pressing issues that concern them in teaching in the field, and device implementation plans that will truly achieve these solutions for the betterment of our education system.

The Teacher’s Summit is a step toward this end. It is a venue where teachers and advocates meet and work together to advance the wellbeing of teachers and envision together a Philippine Education that is shaped by the aspiration of the youth and ordinary people in the land. With the theme “Transforming Philippine Education: Working Together from Ground Up”, it is expected that there will be around 100 public and private school teachers and education students who will attend this Summit. ACT Partylist Representative Antonio Tinio will give the keynote speech on this inaugural event.
