Scholarship applications are due on May 8, 2026.



Warmest greetings from St. Luke's Medical Center Foundation!

Our Foundation, in partnership with the St. Luke's Medical Center College of Medicine – William H. Quasha Memorial (SLMCCM-WHQM), is pioneering a novel Tuition-free Scholarship (TFS) for community physicians. This novel scholarship program addresses one of the most persistent challenges in the Philippine healthcare system: the shortage and inequitable distribution of primary care physicians, particularly in underserved provinces and geographically isolated communities.

Through this initiative, the Foundation aims to expand the pipeline of community-oriented physicians by removing financial barriers and supporting medical school scholars from physician-scarce provinces. The TFS program will provide full financial support throughout their five (5) years of study at the College, enabling deserving students with strong academic potential and commitment to community service to pursue a Doctor of Medicine degree. The scholarship package covers:

- 100% Tuition and School Fees
- Monthly living stipend
- Housing support for rent and utilities
- Clothing allowance
- Laptop and communication support
- Two (2) annual round trip transportation allowances for home visits
- Physician licensure examination review and examination financial support, among others.

In return, scholars shall commit to serve as Doctors for Every Juan (D4Es) for five (5) years in underserved areas in the Philippines. During this service period, they will continue to be supported by the Foundation with competitive salaries and benefits, allowing them to focus on providing quality healthcare to underserved fellow Filipinos while strengthening community health systems.

Through this endeavour, we seek to contribute meaningfully to the national effort to improve equitable access to primary care, strengthen primary care networks, and advance the goals of the country's universal health coverage. **In connection to this, we are asking for your help in referring potential student applicants from**

underserved areas in the Philippines who are studying in your university who would most likely benefit from this Scholarship.
