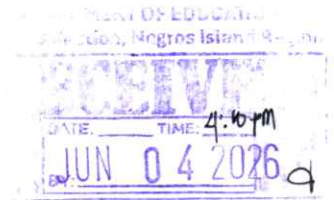

1. MILO Champ Camp is a program that engages with students through sports modules and nutrition without disrupting classes.
