**National Training and Orientation for the Field-Testing Personnel on the
Administration of Various Assessment Programs
for School Year (SY) 2026-2027**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), will conduct a **National Training and Orientation for the Field-Testing Personnel on the Administration of Various Assessment Programs for School Year (SY) 2026-2027** by cluster, with details stipulated below:

Cluster	Regions	Venue	Schedule (inclusive of travel dates)
Luzon	Regions I, II, III, IV-A, MIMAROPA, V, CAR, and NCR	Baguio Teachers Camp, Leonard Wood Rd., Baguio City	August 18 to 20, 2026
Visayas and Mindanao	Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, BARMM, CARAGA, and NIR	TBA	August 26 to 28, 2026 (tentative)

Note: The final schedule and venue for the Visayas and Mindanao Cluster shall be issued in a separate Advisory.

2. The following national assessment programs shall be discussed in the orientation:
 - a. Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA)
 - b. National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6)
 - c. National Achievement Test for Grade 10 (NATG10)
 - d. Regular Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT)
3. The training and orientation will cover the test administration guidelines and procedures, case analysis and evaluation, security of test materials, delivery and retrieval scheme, allocation of test materials, Program Support Funds (PSF), and hands-on training related to the test administration.
4. One (1) Regional Testing Coordinator (RTC) from each Regional Office (RO) and one (1) Division Testing Coordinator (DTC) from each Schools Division Office (SDO) are expected to attend the training and orientation strictly following the schedule per cluster. No additional participants shall be accommodated due to funding restrictions.



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5. The participants must attend only at the scheduled venue where their respective regions are clustered. The Opening Program will commence at exactly 1:00 P.M on Day 1.
6. The travel itinerary of the participants is as follows:

7. All field-testing personnel are encouraged to bring their own laptop and extension cord should the need arise during the training. Additionally, please bring the documentary requirements for the PEPT registrants in your division, if available.
8. Travel expenses and allowable expenses shall be charged to the PSF, which was downloaded to ROs and SDOs except for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region for Muslim Mindanao (BARMM). The PSF was downloaded in 2025 as part of the National Assessment Systems for Basic Education (NASBE) PSF – Second Tranche. The PSF is valid until December 31, 2026.
