**BAGANI: IKALAWANG YUGTO – BATANG BAYANI, TINIG AT LAKAS NG BAYAN**

1. This Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), shall conduct the **“Bagani: Ikalawang Yugto – Batang Bayani, Tinig at Lakas ng Bayan”** during the **Regional Convergence of Education Leaders (RCEL)** on **January 28-29, 2026** at the **Nature’s Village, Talisay City, Negros Occidental**.
2. This activity aims to:
  - design and propose at least one actionable program or initiative that demonstrates enhanced leadership skills and applies life and career competencies to address identified needs within their school community;
  - articulate and integrate the principles of nurturing, inspiring, and resilient leadership by embedding the DepEd core values — maka-Diyos, makatao, makakalikasan, and makabansa — into their leadership commitments and action plans;
  - develop a collaborative learner formation framework that promotes inclusivity, strengthens active learner participation, and aligns with the regional mantra, “For every learner, we rise,” by presenting concrete strategies for implementation; and
  - establish mechanisms for monitoring and evaluating learner formation initiatives to ensure sustainability, responsiveness to learner needs, and alignment with mandated programs, activities and projects of DepEd.

  - Chiefs, Regional Office’s Functional Divisions;
  - Regional Federated Supreme Secondary Learner Government(SSLG) Officers for School Year 2025-2026;
  - Schools Division Superintendents;
  - Assistant Schools Division Superintendents;
  - Chiefs, Curriculum Implementation Division and School Governance and Operations Division; and
  - SSLG Advisers of the Regional Federated SSLG Officers.



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4. Further, the RFSSLG teacher-advisers shall undertake the following responsibilities:

- ensure the safety and security of the learner-participants while traveling to and from the venue;
- ascertain that the learner-participants' needs are adequately addressed throughout the activity; and
- uphold and respect the learner-participants' rights by providing proper guidance, protection, and support at all times.

5. The RFSSLG Officers and Advisers are hereby expected to be at the venue on **January 28, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.**

6. The meals and accommodation of the participants shall be charged against the downloaded Program Support Fund for Youth Formation, while the travelling and incidental expenses to local funds or any available funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
