**CORRIGENDUM AND ADDENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 042 s.2026**  
(PARTICIPANTS TO THE MATH CHRONICLES NATIONAL COMPETITION)

To: Schools Division Superintendents  
All Others Concerned

1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 042 s. 2026 titled Participants to the Math Chronicles National Competition, this Office issues this corrigendum particularly on the meals of the participants.
2. For correction, meals of participants on January 25, 2026 and January 27, 2026 shall be chargeable against local funds, as noted in the JA Philippines' letter dated January 8, 2026, the organization will cover travel expenses (excluding checked baggage), hotel accommodation, and **meals on the day of the event** only.
3. The participants are expected to be at the hotel on January 25, 2026, while departure will be on January 27, 2026, a day after the competition as stated in JA Philippines' letter dated January 23, 2026.
4. In addition, since January 25, 2026 falls on a weekend, teachers shall be entitled to Service Credits for their services but not to exceed 15 days in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 entitled "Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers." On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
5. All other provisions of Regional Memorandum No. 042 s. 2026, not affected by this Corrigendum, remain in effect.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
