**SCHOOL VISIT AND CONSULTATIVE ENGAGEMENT ON SCHOOL
OPERATIONS WITH DEPED CENTRAL OFFICE OFFICIALS**

1. In connection with the forthcoming visit of DepEd Central Office officials to the Negros Island Region, a School Visit and Consultative Engagement shall be conducted on October 8, 2026 to provide an opportunity for direct interaction with school officials, school heads, teachers, and other concerned personnel on actual school operating conditions, staffing arrangements, and related concerns.
2. The activity shall involve the following host schools:
 - a. Negros Oriental High School; and
 - b. West City Elementary School.
3. The engagement aims to provide DepEd Central Office officials with first-hand information and perspectives on:
 - a. Schools operating under single-shift and double-shift arrangements;
 - b. Schools with available or excess teacher capacity;
 - c. Schools reporting teacher shortages and staffing inadequacies;
 - d. Actual teacher deployment, teaching loads, and school-level staffing conditions; and
 - e. Concerns and insights from both active and passive teachers, school heads, and other relevant personnel.
4. The participants of this activity are the following, viz:
 - a. Assistant Regional Director
 - b. Regional Functional Division Chiefs
 - c. The identified personnel of the concerned SDOs:
 - c.1. Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs);
 - c.2. Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDSs);
 - c.3. Chiefs of SGOD and CID;
 - c.4. School Principals/School Heads;
 - c.5. Assistant Principals/Assistant School Heads;

- c.6. Selected teachers representing different teaching assignments and staffing conditions; and
c.7. Guidance Counselors/Coordinators.
5. The identified participants are advised to prepare and bring relevant school data and supporting documents for discussion and validation. The specific data requirements shall be communicated separately upon confirmation by the DepEd Central Office.
6. The Schools Division Offices concerned shall coordinate with the identified host schools to ensure the availability of relevant data, appropriate representation, and necessary logistical arrangements for the activity.
7. There shall be no disruption of classes and only teachers with no scheduled classes shall be involved.
8. Expenses incurred shall be charged against available local funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. The concerned Schools Division Superintendents are requested to coordinate with Mr. Romeo S. Sanchez, Jr., Chief of the Administrative Division, DepEd Negros Island Regional Office for more details.
10. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
