1. The Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes that strengthening the leadership capacity of school leaders is essential to advancing learning recovery and quality education reforms. As DepEd's training arm for the professional development of teachers and school leaders, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) is committed to delivering structured, accountable, and career-aligned professional development programs in accordance with DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2019. Further, pursuant to Republic Act No. 11713 (Excellence in Teacher Education Act), Section 18(b), NEAP is mandated to design and implement programs that strengthen both teaching and leadership competencies.
2. In line with this mandate, NEAP aims to revive the Superintendents' Leadership Program (SLP), and hence, has partnered with the Development Academy of the Philippines-Graduate School of Public and Development Management (DAP-GSPDM) to deliver a high-quality certificate program for Schools Division Superintendents and Assistant Schools Division Superintendents through **Executive Course on Leadership and Public Finance Management (ECLPFM)** in seven (7) batches for FY 2026.
3. The program targets DepEd's priority competency areas, including Public Finance and Budgeting, Public Management, Personal Efficacy and Leadership, and Strategic Foresight and Futures Thinking.
