Activity Title	NGIRIT (Nurturing Grit and Inner Resilience through Integrated Art Therapy)
Rationale	The recent eruption and ongoing activity of Mount Kanlaon have deeply affected both the environment and emotional well-being of nearby communities. Among the hardest hit are teachers from SDO Canlaon City, San Carlos City, La Carlota City, Bago City, and Negros Occidental, who continue to serve despite fear, uncertainty, and emotional strain.
	Recognizing the importance of teachers' emotional health, the Department of Education – Negros Island Region (DepEd NIR), through the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), launches NGIRIT: Nurturing Grit and Inner Resilience through Integrated Art Therapy. This initiative offers a safe and creative space for healing, using evidence-based approaches like art therapy and improvisational theatre to promote emotional release, resilience, and peer support.
	Studies affirm that such expressive activities help manage trauma, prevent burnout, and strengthen teamwork. NGIRIT aims to restore the authentic smiles—ngirit—of teachers through playful, reflective sessions that nurture their well-being and solidarity.
	The program also serves as a platform for teachers to share their experiences and process their emotions within a supportive community. By engaging in collective creativity and storytelling, participants are empowered to make meaning of their struggles, validate one another's journeys, and cultivate a renewed sense of hope and purpose—essential components in the recovery process.
RAPES L.	Guided by DepEd NIR's mantra, "For every learner, we rise," NGIRIT affirms that caring for teachers ensures learning continues—even in crisis. It is a journey toward healing, joy, and shared strength—proof that even amid disaster, we can still laugh, connect, and rise together.
Objectives	The activity aims to:  1. provide a safe and supportive space for teachers to process emotions related to the Mount Kanlaon crisis;
