

This is to officially invite you to the online summit, **"Learning in Every Condition: Insights and Innovations in Blended Learning"** on **July 30, 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m., via Microsoft Teams.**

Frequent class suspensions due to natural hazards, extreme heat, and other disruptions have significantly affected learning continuity nationwide. This recurring loss of instructional time has highlighted the urgent need to institutionalize alternative learning delivery modalities.

Blended learning is increasingly recognized as a viable strategy to mitigate learning disruptions. Some schools have begun piloting hybrid models (e.g., four days in-person, two days remote) to address classroom congestion and suspension-related dislocation.

As such, a blended learning summit will be held on July 30, 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m., via Microsoft Teams, with the title: "Learning in Every Condition: Insights and Innovations in Blended Learning." The objective of the summit is "to convene education stakeholders to assess, design, and promote practical, inclusive, and scalable models of blended learning that respond to the growing frequency of class suspensions and persistent access gaps, with the aim of institutionalizing flexible learning as a long-term strategy for learning continuity and equity."
