

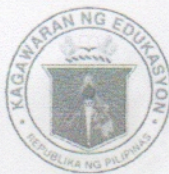

In accordance with Republic Act No. 6759, titled "An Act Declaring August 1 of Each Year as White Cane Safety Day in the Philippines and Other Purposes," the Department of Education (DepEd) reaffirms its commitment to raising awareness on the challenges faced by the blind, promoting the white cane as a symbol of their rights and need for support, and encouraging respect and inclusion.

Relative thereto, the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), will spearhead the **2025 White Cane Safety Day Celebration** with the theme, *Vision beyond sight: celebrating independence, resilience, and recognizing achievements of the blind*, on August 1, 2025, from 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Philippine National School for the Blind, Galvez Avenue, Pasay City, National Capital Region (NCR).

In-person participation is invited from regional and division offices, and schools serving learners with visual impairments in NCR (50 pax), Region III (20 pax), and Region IV-A CALABARZON (20 pax). Other regions are encouraged to hold local celebrations aligned with the theme.
