**PENS UP, RISE STRONG: A BOOTCAMP FOR NIR
SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Pens Up, Rise Strong: A Bootcamp for NIR School Paper Advisers on August 6-8, 2025, at Sea Dream Resort, Sea Dream Drive, Masaplod Sur, Dauin, Dumaguete, Negros Oriental.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. upskill the school paper advisers on the competent use of traditional and digital media platforms;
 - b. apply effective strategies in coaching and mentoring student journalists in various journalistic categories;
 - c. implement a sustainable, learner-centered campus journalism program aligned with Republic Act No. 7079 and the goals of 21st-century education; and
 - d. develop a division-based action plan to strengthen the implementation of campus journalism programs and address the identified training needs.
3. Enclosed are the list of identified participants and the matrix of activities. The participants are expected to register between 11:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and check in at the venue before 2:00 p.m. of Day 1.

6. The walkthrough of the resource speakers is scheduled on July 30-31, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., through a virtual platform.

Meals and accommodation of the participants, resource persons, and Technical Working Group (TWG) members shall be charged against DepEd NIR Funds while the traveling and incidental expenses to local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Considering the proximity of the activity venue, Day 0 meals, accommodation, and incidental expenses of the participants, resource persons, and Technical Working Group members, may also be charged against local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

9. The first meal is PM snacks of Day 1 while the last meal is lunch of Day 3.

10. The activity must be conducted in adherence to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
