In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) continuing efforts to ensure the delivery of quality, accessible, and effective education for all learners, DepEd is undertaking initiatives to address infrastructure-related challenges that affect the safe and convenient access of teachers and students to schools.

In this regard, DepEd is conducting an inventory and/or mapping of broken or damages bridges nationwide that are being used by teachers and students, and which require immediate attention. This initiative aims to identify areas where access to schools is hindered and to facilitate coordination with the concerned national government agencies and/or local government units for the repair, rehabilitation, or construction of such bridges.

Accordingly, all Regional Directors and School Division Superintendents are hereby directed to submit a list of broken or damaged bridges within their respective areas of jurisdiction that impede or significantly affect the access of teachers and learners to schools.
