DATE : May 28, 2025

Republic Act (RA) No. 11510, or the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Act, upholds the State's commitment to promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and to take the appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.

Pursuant to Section 5.5.8 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 11510, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) is mandated to periodically monitor and evaluate ALS programs to determine problems affecting its implementation, and to measure program impact, as well as identify areas for policy and program improvement.

Aligned with the ALS Act and its IRR, and the Department of Education's Five-Point Agenda, the BAE will conduct monitoring of the Opening of ALS Classes for School Year (SY) 2025-2026 on the following schedules:

Monitoring of Opening of ALS Classes in Regions I, II, III, IV, IVB, V, CAR, and NCR	Select Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to be identified by the Monitoring Team	June 18-20, 2025
Monitoring of Opening of ALS Classes in Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, and BARMM	Select SDOs to be identified by the Monitoring Team	June 25-27, 2025

This monitoring aims to:

- gather data on learners' completion rates for SY 2024-2025 to support the evaluation of ALS Key Performance Indicators;





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- identify issues, concerns, and challenges encountered by ALS Implementors during SY 2024-2025;
- document the implementations of ALS across various types of Community Learning Centers namely:
 - School-Based Learning Center
 - Community-Based Learning Center (LGU)
 - Community-Based Learning Center (Private Partner)
 - Learning Centers under the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP)
 - Regional Rehabilitation Center for Youth (RRCY);
- validate learners' enrollment and attendance for SY 2025-2026 and assess discrepancies or innovations in the mapping of prospective learners and registration processes;
- document class programs and plans, learning strategies, and modalities, including pedagogy, andragogy, and heutagogy; and
- collect sample data on learner engagement and transition from monitored SDOs and CLCs.

BAE personnel assigned for this activity will visit one to two SDOs per region. In each SDO, the team will conduct site visits to at least one CLC type. Monitoring activities will include: a) classroom observations, b) interviews with Regional and Division ALS Focal Persons and ALS Implementors, and c) Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) with five (5) ALS learners per CLC.

To facilitate efficient data gathering, all concerned Regional and Division ALS Focal Persons and ALS implementors are requested to accomplish the monitoring forms via the following link <https://tinyurl.com/2526Opening>.
