3. Prior to the conduct of the School-Based Screenings/Film Showing, all Division PEACE Coordinators and School Heads are hereby directed to undertake the following:

- The Division PEACE Coordinators shall disseminate the official link to all School Heads within their respective Schools Division Office.
- The School Heads shall download all film entries from the provided link in preparation for the screening.
- All official entries shall be exhibited during the School-Based Screenings.
- The School Heads shall determine the appropriate venue and schedule of the film showing within the schools.
- A brief content advisory or disclaimer shall be provided prior to the screening to inform learners that some scenes may be emotionally sensitive. Please use the advisory below:

This activity is conducted in accordance with the Department of Education Child Protection Policy (DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012) and existing guidelines on learner safety, mental health, and wellbeing.

The films to be presented are part of the PEACE Short Film Festival and are intended to promote awareness on relevant social issues, including bullying, mental health, discrimination, and other learner protection concerns. As such, some scenes may contain emotionally sensitive content that may evoke strong reactions among viewers.

All learners are advised to watch with guidance and understanding. Should any learner feel discomfort, distress, or emotional difficulty during or after the screening, they are encouraged to immediately inform their teachers, guidance personnel, or any designated school authority.

The schools shall ensure that appropriate psychosocial support and mental health services are available to provide immediate assistance, in line with DepEd's commitment to safeguarding the physical and mental wellbeing of all learners.



 - School-based mental health and psychosocial support services shall be made available throughout the duration of the activity.
 - All activities shall be conducted in accordance with existing DepEd policies on child protection, learner safety, and wellbeing.
