

We are currently undertaking a review of the application of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) across various systems. Adopted in 2017 by the Department of Education, the PPST serves as a key framework guiding recruitment, selection, placement, and induction (RSPI), as well as teacher professional development.

As part of the 2026 review, TEC aims to examine the PPST and related policies in terms of:
