DATE : SEPTEMBER 23, 2025

In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to continuous improvement of basic education programs through evidence-based data from field implementers, the Learning Systems Strand, through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) and Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), will conduct the **Consultative Conference on the Implementation of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) and the National Festival of Talents (NFOT)** on October 1-2, 2025 (exclusive of travel time) at the DepEd Ecotech Center, Cebu City, Region VII.

Prior to this activity, an online survey was administered to gather insights from field implementers/official delegates on the implementation of the NSPC and NFOT.

This activity will convene select field implementers/official delegates to collaboratively revisit the implementation of the NSPC and NFOT in line with the goals of the K to 12 curriculum and DepEd's Five-Point Reform Agenda. Specifically, it aims to:

- A. validate through focus group discussions (FGD) the survey findings, particularly on satisfaction level, funding support, influence on teaching practices and learning behaviors, and sustainability;
- B. identify issues and challenges encountered in the previous conduct of the NSPC and NFOT; and'
- C. formulate action plans to improve implementation and strengthen support systems for the NSPC and NFOT.



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The target participants of this activity are individuals who have previously managed or participated as official delegates in the NSPC and NFOT, and responded to the online survey, specifically **Regional NSPC and NFOT Focal Persons, and selected Schools Division Superintendents, Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) and Division Festival of Talents (DFOT) Focal Persons, Public Schools District Supervisors, and School Heads** (See Annex A: *Distribution of Participants per Region*).
