SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY ASSESSMENT OF
BUILDINGS AND INFRASTRUCTURES WITHIN THE RESPECTIVE
JURISDICTIONS

On September 30, 2025, at 9:59 PM, a 6.9 magnitude earthquake was felt in Bogo City, Cebu. Intensities IV and V were recorded in different locations in Negros Island Region and surrounding provinces. Aftershocks, damages, and minor sea level disturbance were expected as issued in the earthquake and tsunami information issued by PHIVOLCS.

In line with this, all Local DRRM Councils, head of offices, and other stakeholders are hereby directed to conduct an assessment of the structural integrity of buildings and vital infrastructures within your jurisdiction and areas of responsibility. The result of the assessment is necessary in identifying the extent of damage that may pose immediate risks to public safety, for recommendation on appropriate actions for repair, and reports should be consolidated to be submitted to higher authorities for their guidance and recovery measures.
