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In line with the efforts to strengthen the implementation of journalism-related activities and ensure alignment with the conduct of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), the Bureau of Curriculum Development will conduct a **Consultative Workshop on National School Press Conference (NSPC) Guidelines with Supervisors in charge of Campus Journalism** from October 6 to 10, 2025, at the National Educator's Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), Marikina City.

This activity primarily aims to prepare for the conduct of the 2026 NSPC. Specifically, it seeks to:

- a. Identify the strengths of the previous NSPC;
- b. Determine the challenges and areas for improvement;
- c. Align field practices with the national contest standards;
- d. Update the guidelines for the 2026 NSPC; and
- e. Schedule other related-activities such as meetings and capacity-building initiatives for the successful conduct of NSPC.

The Opening Program is on October 6, 2025, at 1:30 p.m. The first meal to be served will be morning snack on October 6, 2025, and the last meal will be afternoon snacks on October 10, 2025.

In this regard, **one regional supervisor** and **one division supervisor** in charge of Campus Journalism are requested to attend the said activity. **All regional supervisors must prepare a five-minute presentation on the Regional Status of Campus Journalism, highlighting key activities, practices, challenges, and recommendations.** The





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presentation must include a brief report on the utilization of downloaded funds for the Regional Schools Press Conference, Regional Training for Campus Journalism, and subsidized travel expenses of student participants. In addition, a written report, duly signed by the Regional Director, must be submitted. This report should include a detailed breakdown of expenses and the total number of student and teacher beneficiaries who received the subsidy.

Travel expenses shall be charged to downloaded 2025 DPCJ Funds. In case the downloaded funds are insufficient, any lacking amount shall be charged against Local Funds, subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
