- The SEAMEO Regional Centre for Special Educational Needs (SEAMEO SEN)
 announces its call for nominations for the Regular Course on Early Support
 Made Practical: Screening and Intervention Strategies for Learners with
 Special Educational Needs, which will be conducted online from 4 to 6
 November 2025.
- 2. This three-day online training program aims to enhance the competencies of educators in implementing early screening and intervention strategies for learners with special educational needs (SEN) in inclusive education settings.
- 3. By the end of the program, participants are expected to:
 - a. Understand the importance and principles of early screening and intervention for SEN learners;
 - b. Identify key developmental, behavioral, and learning indicators for early screening;
 - c. Apply practical and culturally relevant screening tools suitable for diverse classroom contexts;
 - d. Implement evidence-based intervention strategies to support learners' development;
 - e. Collaborate effectively with parents, caregivers, and multidisciplinary teams in designing individualized support plans; and





- f. Develop classroom-based intervention strategies aligned with inclusive teaching practices.

The Scholarship Clearance (Enclosure 2) must also be duly accomplished and submitted.

The Participant Nomination Form and required documents must be accomplished and uploaded (in PDF Form) on or before October 27, 2025, through the Microsoft Office Form which can be accessed through the link https://forms.office.com/r/iSgUn1AKHt. Kindly use official DepEd email accounts in submitting the requirements.
- 7. Please be advised that applications may be disqualified for various reasons, including, but not limited to: incomplete requirements, absence of official endorsement(s), direct submission of applications to the Secretariat's email, or discrepancies in submitted documents, among others.
- 8. Qualified applicants will be notified by SEAMEO-SEN and provided with the details of the online sessions, which are to be presented to their respective School Heads.
- School Heads of qualified participants are expected to provide appropriate support
 by excusing them from classes for the duration of the online program, to ensure
 their full concentration, active participation, and successful completion of the
 course.
- 10. Additionally, School Heads of the qualified participants are expected to make necessary arrangements to ensure that the *No Disruption of Classes Policy* will be strictly observed.






