What is BPMSP?

The Bagong Pilipinas Merit Scholarship Program (BPMSP) is a merit-based scholarship initiative of the administration of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. The program fulfills the commitment to recognize academic excellence, strengthen human capital development, and expand access to quality higher education for deserving Filipino learners.

Who are eligible to apply?

- ✓ Incoming first-year college student
- ✓ Belongs to Top 5 of their graduating class in Grade 12 or with minimum General Weighted Average (GWA) of 95% (or its equivalent) and have not earned any units or degree in tertiary education.
- ✓ From households with not more than Php 2,000,000 annual gross income of parents or guardians
- ✓ Must enroll in priority programs identified by CHED
- ✓ Must render mandatory return service in the country
