

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development - Special Curricular Programs Division, announces the **2026 Europrof Teacher Training Program** for select Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)-Spanish teachers, to be held every **Saturday** via an online platform. The program will start on **May 30, 2026**, with the first group of trainees, while the remaining three groups will begin in subsequent months.



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The program is organized by the Spanish Ministry of Education and Instituto Cervantes, in coordination with the Spanish Embassy in the Philippines, the training provider and partner of the Department in the implementation of SPFL-Spanish.

A total of sixty (60) SPFL-Spanish teachers, as listed in Appendix A, shall participate across four distinct courses:

The Spanish Ministry of Education and Instituto Cervantes will shoulder the DELE A1 exam fees. However, the transportation expenses, accommodation, meals, and other incidental expenses of the teacher-participants during the exam shall be chargeable against the School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund and/or other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.</i></li> </ul>				



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The participating teachers are requested to submit the accomplished **Scholarship Contract**, duly signed by the Regional Director, via email at [bcd.od@deped.gov.ph](mailto:bcd.od@deped.gov.ph) and [scholarships@deped.gov.ph](mailto:scholarships@deped.gov.ph) on or before **June 15, 2026**. The Scholarship Report, meanwhile, shall be submitted through the above email addresses not later than one week upon completion of the program.

The conduct of the online training program on Saturdays ensures that classes will not be disrupted, in adherence to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject *Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities*.

Further, the participating teachers are eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 titled *Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers*.

- a. provide full salary and other benefits and privileges during the scholarship period;
- b. facilitate the return and assumption to duty of the scholar upon completion of the scholarship;
- c. designate mentor/supervisor shall support and jointly implement the Re-Entry Action Plan/ Work Action Plan of the scholar;
- d. the DepEd shall monitor the implementation of the REAP/WAP.

DepEd Scholar shall:

- a. maintain the academic standards and other course requirements set for by the program of the institution and Department of Education (DepEd) and that failure to do so would be sufficient grounds for disqualification and termination of the scholarship;
- b. conduct himself/herself in such manner that will uphold the moral integrity and professionalism of DepEd public servant;
- c. return to official station and resume functions immediately upon the completion or termination of my scholarship or training grant;
- d. at the end of the scholarship or training grant, submit to the head of office and the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) a copy of the scholarship reports containing lessons for the conduct of echo seminars to share new learnings, teaching innovations, and strategies to their co-teachers and administrators; various trainings, program highlights and general impressions constituting my (scholar's) evaluation of the program;
- e. upon return to their station, implement the echo seminars and submit reports to the Professional Development Division, National Educators Academy of the Philippines at Second Floor, Mabini Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City;
- f. shall teach the subject / conduct echo seminars on the course in which they were granted the scholarship and continue to serve their school / division / region for at

least three years which is the service obligation equivalent for a year of scholarship or a fraction thereof;

- g. shall **refund in full** to the Department of Education such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental to my scholarship, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation from the service, transfer to other agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within my control. For reasons beyond the control of the scholar, the conditions do not apply, provided that all documentary requirements including doctor's certification are met and are acceptable to DepEd.
