CONDUCT OF PSYCHOLOGICAL FIRST AID (PFA) ACTIVITIES FOR THE LEARNERS OF TYPHOON-AFFECTED SCHOOLS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. This Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), directs all Schools Division Offices within this Region to conduct **Psychological First Aid** (PFA) activities for the typhoon-affected learners at the school level from November 2025 to February 2026.
- 2. The conduct of **Psychological First Aid (PFA)** activities for typhoon-affected learners aims to:
 - provide immediate psychological support to affected learners to help them cope with the emotional and mental stress brought about by the recent typhoon;
 - promote mental health and well-being among learners through timely intervention and compassionate response in times of crisis;
 - strengthen the capacity of school health and wellness personnel —
 including medical officers, nurses, dentists, DRRM coordinators, and
 guidance counselors in implementing Psychological First Aid at the
 school level;
 - ensure coordinated and systematic delivery of PFA services across all Schools Division Offices within the Region from November 2025 to February 2026; and
 - establish a mechanism for monitoring and reporting the conduct of the school-level PFA through the submission of schedules and accomplishment reports to the Regional Office.
- 3. Anent this, all SDOs are hereby directed to mobilize trained personnel (medical officers, nurses, dentists, DRRM coordinators, guidance counselors, and other personnel) to conduct school-level PFA within the schedule.

In addition, all SDOs shall submit to this Office the proposed PFA implementation plan activities, including schedule and detailed activities, on or before November 17, 2025 via email, nir@deped.gov,ph, (Attn.: Ma. Lira Cynthia B. Quejada, OIC Chief Education Supervisor, ESSD).
- 5. Further, SDOs are encouraged to partner with organizations that can help in the conduct of the PFA.
- 6. Attached are the templates for the schedule and compliance report.
- 7. The conduct of the PFA shall be charged against the school MOOOE fund or any available local funds, all subject to the usual auditing and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
