This Memorandum provides guidance on the conduct of the middle-of-the-school-year (MOSY) assessments for the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program in accordance with Republic Act No. 12028¹, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and DepEd Order (DO) No. 18, s. 2025,² and DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 64, s. 2025³.

The MOSY assessments shall be administered to Grades 1 to 10 learners as part of the ongoing implementation of the ARAL Program.

All schools shall administer the MOSY assessments within the prescribed testing window, irrespective of the program's start date or the number of sessions completed. Schools that have administered the MOSY assessments prior to the issuance of this Memorandum shall no longer be required to do so again.

Table 1 presents the details of the administration of the MOSY assessments for School Year 2025–2026.

The MOSY results of the CRLA for Grade 1 shall determine their participation in the ARAL Program, while for Grades 2 to 10, the results shall guide tutors and teachers in identifying the appropriate next steps for each learner.

All schools are required to encode the results of these assessments after the completion of the MOSY assessments through the submission link: https://bld.deped.gov.ph/submission, not later than December 16, 2025.
