- In line with the Department's continuing efforts to expand teachers' access to continuous, targeted, and high-quality professional development opportunities, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in partnership with Khan Academy Philippines, Inc., shall implement the **Teacher Champions** Fellowship Program – Batch 2 on 20-23 November 2025 at Southview Hotel, National Highway, Lamberto Macias Rd. Dumaguete City, Negros Island Region.
- 2. This professional development program is designed to capacitate teachers and school leaders in the effective integration of the Khan Academy platform in classroom instruction and assessment. The training aims to strengthen learners' foundational mathematical skills through personalized, mastery-based, and impactful learning experiences.
- 3. In support of this, NEAP Central Office shall download HRTD 2024-Continuing Funds amounting to One Million Six Hundred Six Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,606,000.00) to the Regional Offices (ROs) to cover the travel expenses and board and lodging of the participants for the following activity:

- 4. The participants' transportation expenses shall be downloaded to their respective Regions, and the board and lodging shall be charged against HRTD 2024 Continuing Funds while other incidental expenses shall be charged against 2024 Continuing Funds/Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Upon receipt of the Sub-Allotment Release Order, the RO HRDD Chiefs/NEAP R Focal Persons shall do the following:
 - a. Coordinate with the Budget/Planning Officer for the proper updating in the Program Management Information System (PMIS) reflecting the amount of fund received;
 - b. Encode the corresponding activity and its purpose in the PMIS;
 - c. Facilitate the further downloading of funds for the participants from the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) under their respective jurisdictions; and
 - d. Submit a copy of the final list of participants to the SDOs for their reference in processing the travel expenses of their participants.
- 6. The ROs are advised to immediately process the payment/reimbursement of travel expenses of the participants. The participants are expected to submit all travel documentary requirements to facilitate proper liquidation, in accordance with existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. To ensure proper monitoring of fund utilization, the ROs are required to submit their respective Fund Utilization Reports to the NEAP Quality Assurance Division through the link https://tinyurl.com/KHANFURb2 within 40 working days after the completion of the last activity.
- 8. The savings generated after the processing of travel expenses of the participants for the abovementioned activities may be used for other reimbursements of travel expenses related to other activities conducted by NEAP Central Office. On the other hand, should there be any shortage of funds, it is requested that the amount to cover the deficit be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9. The funds to be downloaded shall be distributed to the ROs based on the Allocation List (*Enclosure 1*) provided.
- 10. The List of Participants is provided in **Enclosure 2**. The participants are advised to register and confirm their attendance through the link https://tinyurl.com/TCFPb2 on or before November 17, 2025.
- 11. The Teacher Champions Fellowship Program is not open for sign-ups and is exclusively for teacher-participants from partner public schools who have been





- selected on their exemplary and consistent use of Khan Academy platform from June to September 2025.
- 12. Participants are reminded to bring their own laptops, chargers, extension cords, and reliable sources of internet connectivity (e.g., mobile data, pocket Wi-Fi, etc.) to ensure full participation in all training sessions.
- 13. Participants are advised to check in at 2:00 p.m. on 20 November 2025 and check out at 12:00 p.m. on 23 November 2025. The meal schedule is as follows:




