Additionally, we would like to follow up on the data mapping requested previously, which includes:

- Total number and list of public elementary schools in the region per division and their district
- Total number and list of Grade 4 teachers
- Total number of Grade 4 learners (male and female)

This complete data mapping will help us prepare training kits, allocate materials, and plan session groupings efficiently.

JA Philippines will shoulder transportation and meals for participants during the in-person sessions. All participating divisions and schools will receive the following:

- · Printed and digital teaching materials
- Certificates for participating teachers and schools


