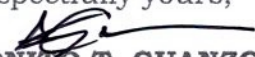
The total amount requested is P311,404.00, representing actual expenses incurred from January to June 2026 in connection with ALS trainings, workshops, and related activities.

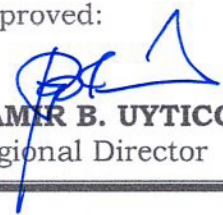

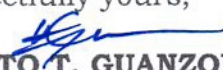
Further, may we respectfully request the inclusion of the following for downloading:

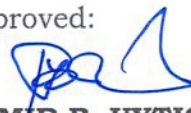

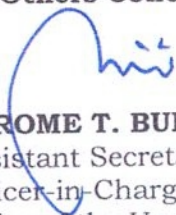

For Fiscal Year (FY) 2026, a total amount of **One Hundred Eleven Million Two Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (Php 111,251,000.00)** has been directly released to the Regional Offices (ROs) under the Flexible Learning Options–Alternative Learning System (FLO-ALS), pursuant to National Budget Circular (NBC) No. 599, titled “Guidelines on the Release of Funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026,” dated January 5, 2026. The released funds shall be utilized to support the implementation of the following FLO-ALS initiatives:

1. **Program Support Fund (PSF) to Regional Offices** – The utilization of PSF shall be in accordance with DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2022, titled “Implementing Guidelines on the Release, Receipt, Utilization, Monitoring and Reporting of Program Support Funds for Alternative Learning System for Calendar Year 2022 and Years Thereafter.” The PSF shall likewise cover expenses for activities organized by the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) under the Support to Operations Component of the Alternative Learning System (ALS), consistent with Items 15 and 19 of the same Order.
2. **Provision of Funds to Balik-Paaralan para sa Out-of-School Adults (BP-OSA) Implementing Schools** – BP-OSA implementing schools shall receive the corresponding initial fifty percent (50%) allocations as reflected in Annex A of this Memorandum. The release of the remaining fifty percent (50%) may be requested by the implementing schools, subject to compliance with the required number of enrollees and in accordance with DepEd Order No. 77, s. 2012, titled “Amended Guidelines for the Alternative Learning System Unified Contracting Scheme.”

The utilization of the funds herein shall strictly adhere to existing budgeting, accounting, auditing, and procurement laws, rules, and regulations. These funds shall remain valid for release, obligation, and disbursement until December 31, 2027, pursuant to the FY 2026 General Appropriations Act (GAA) and NBC No. 599.

Any excess amount or resulting balance may be utilized for expenses related to the implementation of ALS programs, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, auditing and procurement laws, rules and regulations. For this purpose, "related expenses" shall refer to those that contribute to a common particular outcome aligned with the objective of this issuance, specifically involving operational requirements or support services essential to program delivery. These may include the procurement of semi-expandable items, i.e., goods with a unit cost below the capitalization threshold, conduct of workshops and capacity-building activities, travel expenses and other day-day operational needs directly supporting the program implementation.
