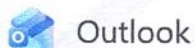

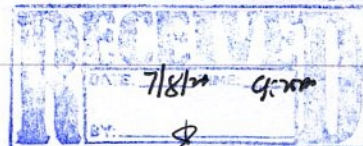

Dear Dr. Uytico,

We are happy once again that this year our international partners have agreed to embark on a new Vocational Training Team project for Bread & Pastry for our Regions! Our partnership will be thru the generosity of RI District 3740 of Chungju, South Korea this time. With your Department's full cooperation, this Literacy and Basic Education project shall be proposed as a global grant with The Rotary Foundation for the benefit of five (5) Cookery instructors and their respective schools and Divisions in Negros Island Region.

As was the case in in our previous batches, if approved, this Rotary global grant shall shoulder all training, training materials and travel expenses (plane fares, board and lodging). We, the local Rotarians, shall assist with visa application as long as the necessary documents and payment(s) are submitted by the deadline set by our visa service provider, details to be sent directly to the concerned parties. The trainings shall be conducted at Chungbuk Health & Science University in Cheongju City. The tentative travel dates of our instructors are January 3-30, 2027, or such dates that we shall both agree on as the more convenient times of the schoolyear that our instructors can go. It is hoped that when the time comes the Department shall still speedily assist our instructors with their respective travel authority and documents needed to make this training possible.

As a first step, again, may we request you to nominate the five (5) instructors for Cookery, preferably from Schools Divisions that have sent instructors before and those whose school(s) have been beneficiaries of donations of related technical-vocational equipment thru Rotary Clubs nearby for ease in sponsorship, coordination and assistance, and possible program expansion efforts.
