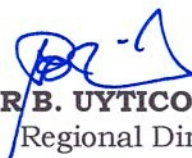

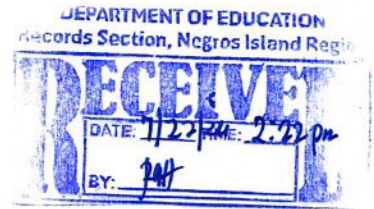

The Learner Government (LG), as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2014 and OUOPS Memo No. 2023-03, is the foremost co-curricular learner-led organization authorized to implement pertinent programs, projects, and activities in all schools nationwide. It serves as a platform for learners to uphold leadership, active participation, and civic engagement while promoting the rights and welfare of Filipino learners.

The National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) is the highest federation of the Learner Government, serving as the foremost representative and voice of learners at the national level. Its contributions have been notably significant in strengthening learner participation and representation in various national engagements, advancing the development of the Youth Education Agenda and the Learner Government Strategic Roadmap 2025-2029, and crafting resolutions that promote and protect learners' rights, welfare, and meaningful participation in governance and education initiatives.

To support the continuous strengthening of learner leadership and representation, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), will conduct the **National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) Elections on July 29-30, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. via Microsoft Teams.**

This activity aims to organize and elect the new NFSSLG officers and board members for School Year (S.Y.) 2026-2027 through a democratic election process and to empower learner leaders through meaningful participation, collaboration, and leadership engagement in governance and youth development initiatives.

## Section 7. Proclamation of Winners

Upon the completion of the canvassing and determination of the winner for each elective position, the Presiding Officer shall immediately proclaim the duly elected officer before the election for the succeeding position commences.

After all elective positions have been filled, the Presiding Officer shall officially recognize all remaining RFSSLG Presidents who were not elected to any national elective position as Board Members.

The decision of the National Election Committee regarding the canvassing, determination of winners, and proclamation shall be final unless a formal election protest is filed. Any election protest must be filed within ten (10) days from the date of proclamation of the elected officer concerned; otherwise, the proclamation shall be deemed final and executory.

## Section 8. Oath of Office

Immediately following the proclamation, the newly elected National Officers and National Board Members shall take their Oath of Office before the designated administering officer.

## Section 9. Adjournment

Upon completion of the Oath-Taking Ceremony, the Presiding Officer shall formally declare the election proceedings adjourned.
