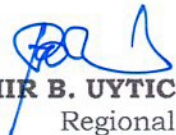

In line with the Department's continuing efforts to strengthen the quality, relevance, and responsiveness of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) programs, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) spearheaded the implementation of Functional Education and Literacy Program (FELP) which aims to provide short-term, competency-based, and context-responsive learning opportunities for ALS learners.

In this connection, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct **Training on the Development of the Functional Education and Literacy Program (FELP) Course Design** on November 4-6, 2026 at Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City intending to further expand the reach of FELP by capacitating field implementers in the development of localized and contextualized FELP courses.

All expenses relative to the conduct of the activities shall be charged against the 2026 FLO-ALS Continuing Funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the downloaded funds comprehensively downloaded to the Regional Offices and shall be reimbursed upon submission of complete travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The downloading of travel expenses funds to the participants' respective Schools Division Offices is highly encouraged whenever necessary and applicable. Should the downloaded funds be insufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, the Program Support Fund (PSF) FY 2026 or local funds will be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.

Attendance of the participants in this activity is highly encouraged; however, participation shall not be mandatory. Participants are also advised to bring their own laptops.

The board and lodging expenses of participants from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) shall be charged against BAE Funds, while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against their respective local funds, subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
