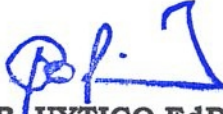

In accordance with the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to enhance the implementation of the Madrasah Education Program (MEP), the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) will conduct a **Consultative Workshop on the Revision of DO No. 30 s. 2012 (Hiring and Deployment of Madrasah Teachers)**, on September 9-11, 2026 at DepEd NCR, Marikina City.

The revision of DepEd Order No. 30, s. 2012 is necessary to ensure that policies on the hiring and deployment of Madrasah teachers are responsive, equitable, transparent, and aligned with current national education priorities.

Through a structured and participatory consultative process, the workshop aims to:

- identify gaps, operational issues, and emerging needs related to the hiring and deployment of Madrasah teachers;
- harmonize policy provisions with existing DepEd issuances on teacher qualifications, deployment, human resource management, and inclusive education;
- strengthen merit-based hiring, proper utilization, and professional support for Madrasah teachers; and
- ensure that policy revisions contribute to improved delivery of Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) and positive learning outcomes for Muslim learners.

The proposed Consultative Workshop serves as a collaborative platform to engage key stakeholders, including Central Office technical experts, Regional and Division Madrasah Education Program Coordinators (RMEPCs and DMEPCs) and partner institutions, in reviewing existing provisions and formulating policy enhancements grounded in field realities.

Accommodation, travel and other incidental expenses will be charged against **2026 Madrasah Education Program (MEP) Current Funds** and other **Local Funds**, should there be deficiencies in the downloaded funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The first meal to be served will be breakfast on **Day 1** (September 9, 2026), and the last meal will be Lunch on **Day 3** (September 11, 2026).
