DATE : August 19, 2026

1. Pursuant to the Department of Education's commitment to continuous professional development and in support of the In-Service Training (INSET) program, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in partnership with the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation (GBF), shall conduct the professional development webinar series titled ILAW in Action: Design and Deliver Effective Lessons through Explicit Instruction via Microsoft Teams Townhall on **September 10-12, 2026**.

2. Recognizing current challenges in learner achievement, the webinar series equips K to 12 teachers with practical instructional practices that translate well-designed lesson plans into effective classroom delivery. Participants will examine Explicit Instruction as an evidence-informed approach and learn to integrate its principles into DepEd's lesson planning framework: Intentions, Learning Experiences, Assessment, and Ways Forward (ILAW).

3. The webinar series is open to K to 12 teachers nationwide and will be hosted via Microsoft Teams Townhall, with all official webinar links, registration forms, evaluation tools, and downloadable materials accessible through the resource hub at **bit.ly/m/gbfstemcollabcommunity**.

4. Likewise, the webinar series aims to enable participants to:

- Explain the rationale, components, and purpose of the ILAW Framework and its support for various instructional strategies, including Explicit Instruction.
- Design coherent lesson plans using the ILAW Framework that incorporate explicit explanation, modeling, guided practice, and the gradual release of responsibility.

- Apply Explicit Instruction in classroom settings using the I Do → We Do → You Do sequence while managing lesson pacing and learner engagement for skill mastery.
- Analyze lesson plans and classroom teaching practices through reflection and feedback to strengthen overall instructional effectiveness.

5. Interested participants are required to register through the official GBF STEM Collab community page at bit.ly/m/gbfstemcollabcommunity, where the official Webinar Series links, evaluation, LAC Guide, downloadable templates and other related announcements will be posted.
