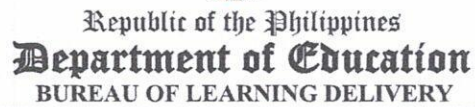

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), will spearhead the project **"Structured Pedagogy for the Junior High School (KS3) PRIMALS in All Learning Areas"** to strengthen Junior High School teachers' pedagogical and assessment practices in alignment with the Revised Curriculum and national assessment demands. The initiative aims to improve the quality of instruction and learner outcomes by equipping teachers with structured, evidence-based, and classroom-responsive teaching approaches while integrating Content Area Reading (CAR) to **strengthen literacy development and improve learning outcomes** across all learning areas.

To ensure continuity, coherence, and quality of outputs throughout the resource package development process, the same set of participants shall attend all activities from the Onboarding Workshop to the Facilitation Practicum Workshop, except for the Validation Workshop, which shall involve a separate pool of validators. The list of participants is provided in Annex 1.

Participants are expected to arrive at the venue by 8:00 a.m. on Day 1 of each activity, with AM snacks served as the first meal and PM snacks as the last meal. Annex 2 contains the indicative program of activities. Participants are also advised to bring their laptop computers, extension cords, relevant reference materials, and approved travel authority.

Board and lodging expenses shall be charged against the 2026 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Continuing Funds, while traveling expenses of field participants shall be charged against the downloaded funds to each region through the 2026 Program Support Funds (PSF) for Travelling Expenses of Field Participants for Various Activities of the Bureau of Learning Delivery – Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD), subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) will be granted in lieu of workshop days that will fall on holidays, in accordance with CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2015, Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees.
